Enquiries regarding the results of learners will be dealt with in the new year :

12 – 23 January 2026

Re-marking of Papers

Requests for a re-mark of November Examination papers will only be accepted from 12 – 23 January 2026. The relevant documentation must please be completed by the parents (only) of the learners. These documents are available at the front office. No learner will be allowed to complete a request form for a re-mark of papers. No adjustment of marks will be made to marks without the re-mark of exam papers.

Please note that the marks of learners are calculated as follows:

Senior Phase 2025 (Grade 8 and 9)

The school based assessment (the year mark) counts 60% of the final promotion mark. The November Examination mark counts 40% of the final promotion mark.

FET Phase 2025 (grade 10 and 11)

The school based assessment (the year mark) counts 40% of the final year mark. The November Examination mark counts 60% of the final promotion mark.

It is therefore possible for a learner to have passed throughout the year, but still fail the grade if the learner did not achieve a pass mark in the November Examination.

Condonation

No additional marks will be given (condonation) to learners in grade 10 and 11. The learners must achieve the pass requirements set out by the Department of Education in order to be promoted to the next grade. **Please do not expect the school management to have pity on a learner and therefore add marks to allow him or her to pass. No policy condones the practice of condonation in the FET phase.**

Doctor's note

No doctor's note for the November exam will be accepted after the reports have been handed out in December 2025.

Progression

Progression may only be awarded to learners in the grade 8 and 9 phase if:

1. The learner has handed in all the SBA tasks in all the subjects taken in grade 8 or 9.
2. The learner has already failed in grade 7 - 9. The learner can then be progressed, due to number of years in the Senior Phase.
3. The learner was not absent for more than 20 days without a valid reason.

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE PROGRESSION CRITERIA FOR GRADE 8 AND 9 LEARNERS ARE DIFFERENT FROM GRADE 10 AND 11 LEARNERS.

Progression may only be awarded to learners in gr 10 and 11 if:

1. The learner has completed all the SBA tasks in all their subjects.
2. The learner was not absent for more than 20 days without a valid reason.
3. The learner has failed grade 10 or 11 before.
4. The learner has a minimum of 30% for his Home Language and the learner must have passed LO with 30% and two more subjects with 30%.

P = Promoted

NP= Not Promoted

PG= Progressed

Subject Changes

Grade 11 Learners:


- A maximum of one subject may be changed in grade 11 before the end of March.
- Learners who change pure Maths to Maths lit. cannot take Physical Science and will have to change a second subject as well.
- Learners will not be allowed to change three subjects.


Grade 10 learners:

- May change two subjects before the end of June. If a learner had changed two subjects in Gr. 10 they will not be allowed to change subjects in Gr. 11.

It is important to choose the correct subjects in Gr. 10. It is not a matter of let's just give it a try and hope for the best. The options to change subjects are narrowing and it is important to listen to the advice given to learners and parents by educators in order to avoid disappointment in Gr. 12. Too many learners fail Gr. 12 because of the wrong subject choices. Please let this not be the situation for our learners.
